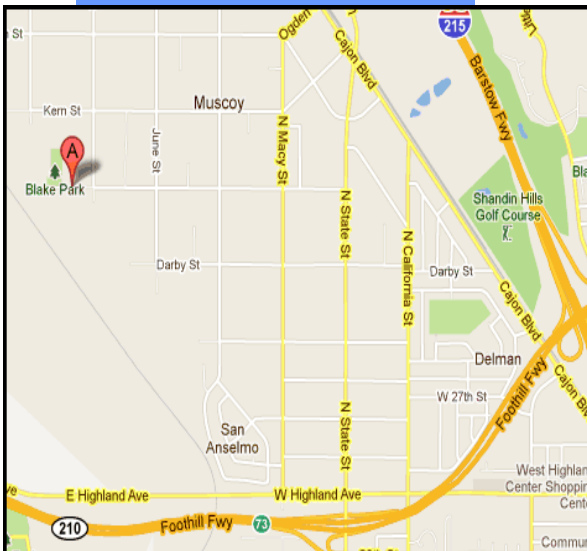


The Power Of Education

The Admission Process

Parent or Legal Guardian must be present.

1. Call for an application and an admission interview.
2. Bring the following documents to the Admission Interview:
 - A) Application
 - B) Official Transcript
 - C) Discipline Records
 - D) CST/CAHSEE test scores
 - E) T-Dap immunization records
 - F) Attendance report
3. Admission notification will be made within 48 hours
4. Successful applicants take an assessment test to determine proper class placement
5. Parent/Student meet with Principal/Counselor for counseling and Master Agreement Contract.
6. Student begins schools

The Admission process takes 2 to 5 days
